

TERRACYCLE COLLECTION (Last updated: 7-30-21)

The Green Team of First United Methodist Church, 203 Wisconsin Av, Madison is partnering with Monona Public Library and Terracycle by trying to make it easy and convenient to collect and recycle some 'hard to recycle' items that are not collected in our local recycling systems. We send these items to Terracycle and we get a small profit from the items we send in.

Please package each category separately. Hint: Don't bag items in clean zip lock bags – use paper bags or old bread bags or some other pre-used plastic bag.

***Category 1:** Britta filters, pitchers, dispensers, bottles, faucet systems and packaging.

***Category 2:** Flexible Plastic Packaging - any packaging with these labels: Kroger, Private Selection, Simple Truth, Simple Truth Organic, HarrisFares, Comforts, Lovsome & other Kroger Company Brands

***Category 3:** Pouches and caps from squeezable fruit & veggie snacks (ex. Go-GO Squeeze)

***Category 4:** Aluminum and plastic drink pouches and straws (NO drink boxes)

***Category 5:** Markers and pens that no longer work

***Category 6:** Old toothbrushes, toothbrush packaging, empty toothpaste tubes, dental floss containers, bar soap wrappers, empty deodorant containers

***Category 7:** Non-recyclable parts from the containers of any brand cleaning products (pumps, caps, triggers and soft pouches)

***Category 8:** Personal Care (including lipstick and makeup) packaging; vitamin, mineral and supplement packaging; cough, cold, flu, sore throat and nasal care packaging; and infant formula and child nutrition packaging

****Category 9:** Any eyeglasses, sunglasses (prescription or not) & glass cases and hearing aids (even if repair is needed)

****Category 10:** 'Late July' Snack bags

****Category 11:** Any brand of coffee bags

****Category 12:** Little Bites Snack Bags

****Category 13:** Styrofoam packing, Styrofoam egg cartons and CLEAN meat trays. (These items can also be dropped off at: Reynolds Urethan Recycling located at 2701 Progress Rd, Madison WI.) NO PEANUTS

****Category 14:** Inner linings of cereal boxes, plastic grocery bags, bread bags, case overwraps, dry cleaning bags, newspaper sleeves, ice bags, plastic resealable bags, produce bags, bubble wrap, salt bags. (Many of these items can also be dropped off at retail grocery stores).

****Category 15:** Arm and Hammer pouches and Oxyclean pouches

*** One starred items can be dropped off at:**

1. Monona Public Library, 1000 Nichols St, Monona WI (green bins located outside Nichols St. entrance) and at
2. First United Methodist Church, 203 Wisconsin Av, Madison (drop off on Sunday mornings 9 to noon) or Monday thru Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (If door is locked ring the bell) **DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS UNATTENDED AT THE FRONT DOOR OF THE CHURCH).**

**** Two starred items can be dropped off at:** First United Methodist Church, 203 Wisconsin Av, Madison (see times listed above)
